how could a woman be three times accused of witchcraft and go on running a successful farmstead why would men use a frying pan for cattle magic why did witches keep talking about the children what kind of a relation did finnish witches have with authority and power these are among the questions raisa maria toivo addresses in this study as she explores the gender implications of the complex system of household management and public representation in which seventeenth century finnish women and men negotiated their positions from specific case studies toivo broadens her narrative to include historiographical discussion on the history of witchcraft on women s and gender history and on early modern social history shedding new light on each theme toivo contributes to the on going discussion in the european historiography about whether the early modern period witnessed an improvement decline or simply alteration in the conditions of oppression of women within patriarchal households by using a multidimensional set of roles that could be adopted by women finally she demonstrates convincingly that members of the solid peasant class were not only subject of the newly forming states but also avid users of the court system which they manipulated and put to work in the interests of their own individual household and collective affairs

magic always part of the occult underground in north america has experienced a resurgence since the 1960s although most contemporary magical religions have come from abroad they have found fertile ground in which to develop in north america who are today s believers in witchcraft and how do they worship alternative spiritual paths have increased the ranks of followers dramatically particularly among well educated middle class individuals witchcraft and magic conveys the richness of magical religious experiences found in today s culture covering the continent of north america and the caribbean these original essays survey current and historical issues pertinent to religions that incorporate magical or occult beliefs and practices and they examine contemporary responses to these religions the relationship between witchcraft and neopaganism is explored as is their intersection with established groups practicing goddess worship recent years have seen the growth in new age magic and afro caribbean religions and these developments are also addressed in this volume all the religions covered offer adherents an alternative worldview and rituals that are aimed at helping individuals redefine

themselves and make their interactions with the environment more empowered many modern occult religions share an absence of dogma or central authority to determine orthodoxy and have become a contemporary experience embracing modern concerns like feminism environmentalism civil rights and gay rights afro caribbean religions such as santería palo and curanderismo which do have a more developed dogma and authority structure offer their followers a religion steeped in african and hispanic traditions responses to the growth of magical religions have varied from acceptance to an unfounded concern about the growth of a satanic underground and as magical religions have flourished increased interest has resulted in a growing commercialization with its threat of trivialization

we are witnessing a new surge of interpersonal and institutional violence against women including new witch hunts this surge of violence has occurred alongside an expansion of capitalist social relations in this new work that revisits some of the main themes of caliban and the witch silvia federici examines the root causes of these developments and outlines the consequences for the women affected and their communities she argues that no less than the witch hunts in sixteenth and seventeenth century europe and the new world this new war on women is a structural element of the new forms of capitalist accumulation these processes are founded on the destruction of people s most basic means of reproduction like at the dawn of capitalism what we discover behind today s violence against women are processes of enclosure land dispossession and the remolding of women s reproductive activities and subjectivity as well as an investigation into the causes of this new violence the book is also a feminist call to arms federici s work provides new ways of understanding the methods in which women are resisting victimization and offers a powerful reminder that reconstructing the memory of the past is crucial for the struggles of the present
